Sub:- Intensive Medical Health Camp during Deepawali festive season during Oct. 2017.

Dear All,

As you are aware that we are organizing an intensive health camp & communication activities under the Migration Campaign which has been planned in close coordination between NRMH, District Health Society and Rajasthan State AIDS Control Society (RSACS). The health camps are being held in 10 districts at locations which are having large number of out migrant households. Detailed micro plan is to be developed under your supervision for the district. Nodal officer from RSACS are visiting your districts shortly for holding a meeting with all line departments for planning of the camps. Orders for deployment of staff and other medicines and consumables can be the same as during the last year campaign held in 10 districts. New districts will be shared the copy of the orders for reference.

As per the guidance of NACO and instructions thereafter, the following activities are to be undertaken during the camps;

- A district level meeting is to be held for identifying villages which have high number of out migrants households. This information is to be obtained and collated from ASHA /AWW Village Enumeration Register or a rapid survey of a day may be undertaken by AWW and ASHA to make the list of the same. DPM and District ASHA Coordinator is to be assigned the responsibility for the same. The information with the line listing is to be shared with RSACS at the earliest and with the District Nodal Officer of RSACS.
- It is also expected by you to provide all support to the Nodal Officer for effective planning and implementation of the campaign.
- These intensive health camps are to offer complete health checkups and associated health services to the visiting population including complete range of health counseling, checkups, diagnosis, treatment and services including referrals and linkages when needed, to all the visiting population. The camps shall cover at least the following services- General check up, Reproductive & Maternal Health & including STI/ HIV, ANC/PNC, Routine immunization, linkages between ICTC-DOTS, Condom promotion etc.
- District level instruction are to be issued to PRIs, ICDS/ DWCD, NYKS and other stakeholders to work in mobilizing masses to avail health camp services.
- Nomination of Doctor In-charge for the camp who would report daily by the end of the day to RSACS in the format. Name of the Doctor in charge is to be intimated at the earliest.
- Ensure that there are doctors offering complete health checkups- General Physicians, Female doctors and pediatricians and associated treatment at the camp site for the complete duration of the camp and the para-medical staff as well.
- For any other health complication/ serious patients, referral to the nearest facility is to be ensured and follow up by the camp nodal doctor with the details of the referred is to be shared for records and follow up by the state.
- Press release covering the venue, camp dates and services offered is to be given in the local newspapers and the clipping to be shared with RSACS.

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- Depute District ASHA coordinator and corresponding block ASHA supervisor for mobilization by the ASHA s for the camp site village and 3-4 surrounding villages for optimum uptake of services. Also support is to be sought from DDs-ICDS and corresponding CDPOs for utilizing the services of Lady Supervisor, AWW/Helper for mobilizing the masses to avail the facilities offered during the camps
- Services of the camp site are to be for the whole duration of the camp i.e. from 9 AM to 5PM.
- Daily report is to be monitored by the District authority on regular basis,
- Mobility support to the camp teams through MVs for all the camps sites.
